He is involved with a church missionary group assisting to improve school conditions in a village of northern Haiti on the island of Hispaniola. Haiti is the poorest nation of Latin America; continuously in political turmoil. Fred said that 80% of the population is poverty stricken. His impression of the Haitian people is that they are warm and pleasant human beings. Over one million school-age children are living in poverty in this small nation. Fred's missionary group succeeded in building a school in the village of Limonade with the assistance of the Living Hope Mission in Haiti. There is little local government structure in the rural villages. Potable water is in short supply. Much is needed to relieve the poverty in this country.
