**Modern Indian Artist Exhibition** – Govinda Malya has brought to our attention that the art works of Nandalal Bose (1882-1966) is on display at the Philadelphia Museum of Art until September 1. **Los Angeles RI Convention** – On July 24<sup>th</sup> Larry Whitaker presented to We-Go his memories of the RI Convention held from June 15 to 18. Nearly 20,000 Rotarians attended from some 160 countries. Larry said that the convention was very well organized. Larry enjoyed all the events, and he especially enjoyed talking to great number of Rotarians. The Natalie Cole concert was great. Flags from the many countries present were displayed. The conference emphasized the many world projects that Rotarians are involved in: literacy, aids, world hunger, polio eradication, world health. RI will hold its 2009 conference in Birmingham, England.

**Adult Day Care Presentation** – Rick Hynes, a retired chemist, talked of his involvement with Sarah Care, a health related care for seniors during the day in an upscale country club-like center. His center is located in the heart of the Great Valley Corporate Center, just off Rt. 29, north of Rt. 202. The center is open from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m. The elderly cared for are primarily victims of Alzheimer’s or some form of Dementia. Sarah Care is a uniquely designed program that provides safe and active environments for seniors who require assistance during the day and provide peace of mind for their family members who need to continue working or need respite. The cost is \$81 a day.
